Dear Valued Cargo Customer,

As part of our integration into a single carrier, Continental and United have begun harmonizing our surcharges. Continental Airlines Cargo will make the following changes to our fee structure for U.S. and Puerto Rico origin shipments effective March 7, 2011.

The current Security Surcharge will be renamed the Freight Processing Fee. The Freight Processing Fee of \$.06 per pound for domestic shipments and \$.15 per kilo for international shipments will be assessed on all shipments tendered screened or unscreened.

A separate Security Screening Fee of \$.04 per pound for domestic shipments and \$.12 per kilo for international shipments will be assessed on all shipments tendered unscreened. Customers who deliver CCSF pre-screened freight will not be charged the Screening Fee; however, all shipments will be charged the Freight Processing Fee.
